2009 Pan Am Adult Summer Hockey League Official Rules

The 2008/2009 USA Hockey Rules manual for adult recreational hockey with the following modifications and guidelines for conduct will govern all Pan Am Hockey games.

ALL PLAYERS MUST BE REGISTERED FOR 2008/2009 OR 2009/2010 season USA Hockey (visit www.usahockeyregistration.com to register). Please submit a copy of your USAH registration to League Commissioner.

1. Each team roster will consist of a maximum of 16 players (15 and 1 goalie). All team rosters are subject to the review and approval of the league commissioner.
2. All league fees must be paid in full at the time of registration; only registered, paid players will be allowed to get on the ice. No substitute players will be allowed without consent from the league commissioner.
3. Only current, rostered players who have played in regular season league games may participate in the playoffs.
4. All game misconduct penalties will be subject to review by the league commissioner and I/WSA management, disciplinary action (if any) and follow-up (which may include additional game suspensions and/or dismissal from I/WSA's Hockey Programs).
5. Board checking and open ice checking is prohibited. Incidental contact is allowed.
6. Shots above the waist and slapshots are allowed.
7. The red line will not be played (two line pass and icing calls).
8. Minor penalties will be three minutes. Major penalties will be seven minutes.
9. Minor penalties may be awarded for excessive and/or abusive language directed towards game officials.
10. There will be a 3 minute warm-up prior to each game.
11. Each game will consist of three 20 minute periods with running clock. If the score differential in the third period is three (3) goals or less, the last three (3) minutes of the third period will be played with stop clock.
12. Tie scores during regular season games will be followed by a three player shoot-out then sudden death shoot-out. Tie scores during playoff games will be followed by a five- minute sudden death overtime and then by a sudden death shoot-out until the tie is broken.
13. Each team will be allowed ONE time out per game.
14. If a team has insufficient players to start a scheduled game, the game may be forfeited to the opposing team and points for a win will be scored to the opposing team statistics. The open ice time may be used by the players present for practice or scrimmage.
15. League rules can be amended, as necessary, by the I/WSA management.
16. Major disputes of rules violations will be reviewed and acted upon, as necessary, by the league commissioner and I/WSA management.
17. All referee decisions are final.

The ultimate goal of this league is to provide fun, recreational hockey for all players.
