2010 SUMMER HOUSING HANDBOOK
Exhibit Hall, Indiana State Fairgrounds

Housing for the 2010 Indiana/World Skating Academy Summer School will be provided at the Indiana State Fairgrounds in the Exhibit Hall Apartments, located approximately 15 minutes North of the Academy. The cost for housing this summer is \$345.00 per week and includes all meals, supervision, and transportation to and from the rink. There will be no pro-rating for stays less than one week, unless it is for a weekend clinic (\$55/night). The head housemother will be Dorothy Martin.

Airport Transportation

Roundtrip transportation to and from the airport is available for \$50. This service must be arranged with the housemothers at least **one week** in advance and is not available after 7pm. Please call the I/WSA office, **(317) 237-5565 or Dorothy Martin (317) 529-8837**.

Check-in

Check-in Time: Sunday, 3:00 p.m.-5p.m., Eastern Daylight Savings Time (same as New York), at the Exhibit Hall Apartments at the Indiana State Fairgrounds. Please call ahead to arrange a different time, if necessary.

Room Assignments & Roommates

Sleeping quarters are apartment-style (separate bedrooms with 2-4 bunk beds). Clothes and personal belongings are stored in dressers.

Supervision

There will be one housemother and/or an assistant who will work together, as schedules demand, throughout the entire week. The housemothers have complete authority at all times in the summer housing unit. All outings will be supervised.

Room Furnishings & Decorations

Each skater will be provided a bed, dresser drawers, and hanging space. **Skaters must provide their own pillow, sheets, toiletries and towels.** Each skater is responsible for maintaining her area in a reasonably neat and clean condition at all times. Skaters are also expected to assist the housemothers in keeping the kitchen and common areas neat.

Consideration Hours

Consideration hours (the absence of loud noises or distractions) are in effect from 9:00 pm to 7:00 am, Sunday through Thursday.

Food Services

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided for all skaters in housing. Lunch will be served at the Academy. Breakfast & dinner will be served in housing. On weekends, all meals will be served at the Indiana State Fairgrounds in the Exhibit Hall Apartments. The food will be purchased by the housemother and used to her discretion. Snacks will be provided on a reasonable basis. One night each week, the housemothers will take the skaters out to eat or they will have a pizza night.

Refunds

No refunds will be issued for any reason after June 1, 2010. Housing availability is limited due to space constraints. Therefore, refunds cannot be issued.

Damages

The skater shall use the premises, personal property and furnishings of the Indiana State Fairgrounds in a careful and proper manner. Assigned occupants of each living area are financially responsible for keeping the house & their rooms in good order and free from damage by themselves or others. Damage fees will be charged for negligent or malicious damage.

Medical Visits

Medical visits that are not emergencies can be scheduled with the housemother. The fee is \$25.00/per visit. In addition, the parent(s)/guardian(s) must make arrangements for payment with the attending physician's office, prior to the appointment.
