I hereby give my permission for _____
to attend regularly scheduled off-campus or premises field trips. They will be accompanied by responsible I/WSA staff members or their house mothers for all I/WSA scheduled trips and events. Trips have previously included: Movie theaters, amusement parks, city pools, Indianapolis Zoo, the Children's Museum and shopping malls.

Field trips will be taken periodically. It is best if skaters are supplied with some spending money for movies and weekend activities. It makes it very difficult to keep the skaters together as a group on the weekend when one skater in the group is unable to participate in activities due to financial considerations.

I give my permission for my child to go outside the Indiana/World Skating Academy during the day to go to various downtown shopping centers including the Circle Centre Mall. They will NOT always be accompanied by their house mothers or supervising adults. By signing this permission slip, I am authorizing permission for my child to leave the Academy unsupervised.

If your child is allowed to go on unsupervised outings, the following guidelines will apply:

1. Skaters may not leave the facility alone.
2. Skaters must check out at the I/WSA Office before leaving and report an estimated time of return. They must also check in immediately upon returning to I/WSA.
3. Skaters must wear street clothes when they leave the building. They are not allowed to walk around and shop outside the facility in skating dresses and tights. Skaters should be properly dressed.
4. Skaters must present this signed form before obtaining permission from I/WSA to leave.
5. Skaters will only have permission to leave the I/WSA facility during the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 pm.

NOTE: If this form is not signed, the student will not be allowed to leave the I/WSA facility or the premises of the Indiana State Fairgrounds dormitory area. Permission to leave the Academy or the I/WSA housing facility is under the discretion of the House Mothers or I/WSA staff and may be refused.
